### How about producing a science newsletter, webpage or blog?

#### ★ You will need

- access to a computer.
- access to suitable software.
- information and pictures.

#### ★ Think about

Do you know anyone using any of these ways to communicate? Your science club or school might be able to help. It's much easier to write a page for a newsletter than to set up a newsletter yourself, or add a page or blog to a website than set up the website yourself. Which would you feel most confident doing? A page for a newsletter might be simplest. A blog might be hardest. An adult who produces newsletters or websites might give you advice.

Who is your audience? Will it be young children, older children, adults or a mixture?

What science topics are you interested in? What science topics do you think other people might be interested in? What have you learnt or heard about recently that you want to share? Will you need to do any extra research?

What do other people think about your ideas? Show some people a draft of your work. Talk about how you might be able to improve it.

#### ★ Communicate

Tell people about what you have produced. Show it to family and friends, at a club or at school. See how they respond to it. Do they have any ideas that they might want to add?
